2. All video submitted will be judged and approved by the Wasatch Magazine editorial staff and guest judges in the outdoor film industry.

4. To submit a film it must be done on YouTube.
 - a. Upload your film to YouTube.
 - b. Visit the website Wasatchmag.com/filmfest and fill out the form. You will need to paste the youtube link at the end of the form.
5. A film will be ineligible if:

- a. It has had any sort of public theatrical screening
- b. If the film is Trademarked.
- c. If the film has been a part of a crowdfunding campaign.
